



Vertebrates

Mammals

- Have fur / hair
- Feed milk to their young
- Warm blooded - keep the same body temperature
- give live birth- no eggs

Birds

- Have beaks
- Have feathers
- Most fly
- Hollow bones
- Hatch from eggs
- Feed their young-not milk
- warm blooded

Reptiles

- Cold blooded-Their body temperature changes a lot
- Dry, scaly skin
- Hatch from eggs
- Do not feed milk

Amphibians

- Can live on water and land
 - and can breathe on land and underwater
- Breathe through their skin
- Skin is moist, cool and soft
- Cold- blooded
- Hatch from eggs
- metamorphosis- Starts out as one thing, and turns into something else
- Tadpoles become frogs
- Do not feed milk

Fish

- Breathe through gills
- Cold blooded
- Hatch from eggs
- Have fins
- Have scales
- Do not feed milk

Invertebrates

Arthropods

- Have exoskeleton - skeleton on the outside instead of inside
- Jointed legs - legs bend
- Hatch from eggs
- Cold blooded

Mollusks

- Soft, squishy bodies
- Don't have bones
- Some have a shell - not an exoskeleton
